Seekonk Meadows Use Policy

Seekonk Meadows offer stewardship of a nine-acre recovered natural setting that provides passive recreation opportunities and environmental education to members of the Seekonk community. Passive recreational activities are allowed that do not endanger the capped landfill and respect other users. Passive recreational activities include: Walking, running, wildlife observation, photography, and snowshoeing. Gatherings in the Meadows are limited to the amount of available parking spaces and the capacity of the amphitheater. Any private gathering of over 30 persons is required to obtain a permit for use. Requests for use forms for the amphitheater, private gatherings or other uses will be reviewed at the monthly meeting of the Seekonk Meadows Committee and then forwarded to the Seekonk Library Board of Trustees for final determination.
